How do I enroll with Seton?

- 1 Please read and understand the accompanying tuition contract materials, which specify Seton's procedures.
- 2 Fill out the Application for Admission, entering student information for each enrolling student, and parent information.
- 3 Fill out and sign the enrollment contract. At that point, you can fax, mail, or call Seton to complete enrollment.

Special Instructions

If you want to receive credit for books you already own ...

- Check the box next to any book you **DO NOT** need. Book credits apply only to books you would normally receive upon enrollment. The year in parentheses indicates the edition that corresponds to the current lesson plans.
- Total the amount of credits as indicated. Subtract this amount from the enrollment total. Return the book credit form with your Enrollment Contract.
- Note that book credits can only be given at the time of enrollment. Credits cannot be given after books have been shipped.

GENERAL ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

How do I enroll?

Enrolling is easy. Please fill out the *Enrollment Contract* and *Application for Admission* in the back of this brochure. Please be sure to note any courses not on the student's grade level. Please mail the forms to us with your payment. You may enroll by telephone, by e-mail, on-line, or by FAX, if you are paying by credit card.

After receiving the Application and Enrollment Contract forms and payment, Seton will send to new families a copy of the *Catholic Home Schooling Handbook*, placement tests

(if needed), transcript release forms, and, in grades 7-12, a mini study skills course.

After administering the placement tests, return them to us for grading and evaluation. Once we have evaluated the placement tests, we will send you the appropriate curriculum or, if need be, call you for further discussion regarding your child's placement. For grades 9-12, a high school counselor will contact you for final course selection and approval, if needed.

PROGRAM FEES

Basic fees for enrollment can be found on the Enrollment Payment Contract.

NEW FAMILY APPLICATION FEE: New families (or those who have gone for more than one year without having a child enrolled) must pay the NEW FAMILY APPLICATION FEE. For this you will receive the placement tests (if enrolling in a full program), transcript release forms, a subscription to our newsletter, a mini study skills course (Grades 7-12), and a copy of Dr. Clark's *Catholic Home Schooling Handbook*. This fee is paid at the same time as the Base Program Fees. It must be paid by any new family, whether enrolling in a single course or a full program.

KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT FEE: This Fee pays for all the student books, the tuition, counseling services, the lesson plans, and the shipping and handling for kindergarten.

BASE PROGRAM FEES: The Base Program fee chart on the Enrollment Contract gives the current prices for full programs in grades 1-12, which include all textbooks, workbooks, lesson plans, counseling, tuition, tests, grading, and shipping and handling. Only the lesson plans must be returned; you keep all the books. Lesson plans should be returned upon completion of the work or within 12 months of the date of shipment, whichever comes first, unless an Extension Fee has been paid.

A full program for high school includes up to six credits per year. Additional credits may be taken at our regular single course rates.

MIDDLE SCHOOL AND JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL FEE: This covers the additional cost of middle school and junior high

school materials. It must be paid at the same time as the Base Program Fees.

HIGH SCHOOL FEE: This fee pays for the cost of the high school textbooks, the high school counselor's evaluation of previous credits, selection of courses for current and future high school programs, the creation and updating of the files necessary for high school academic record keeping, and the additional costs for grading and counseling. Each child enrolling or re-enrolling in a high school full program must pay this fee at the same time as the Base Program Fees.

MATH FEES: Seton uses Saxon math starting with Saxon 54. The cost to purchase any of the used Saxon math books or solutions manuals is \$20 per book regardless of grade level. Please circle the books you need on the Enrollment Contract. If you already own the appropriate textbook, there is no need to purchase it. If you do not own the appropriate text, you will need to purchase it from Seton or from another source. (The Houghton-Mifflin Geometry book and manual are also \$20 each. Our website has more information about math choices.)

MATH CD: The D.I.V.E. into Math CD-ROMs are an excellent math instruction tool for every grade level from Saxon 54 to Calculus. This interactive program teaches each concept in the Saxon math book with easy to understand lesson presentations. Saxon Teacher, Algebra I and II, and Advanced Math are now available. For more information, see our website.

SHIPPING AND HANDLING FEES: Shipping fees for shipments within the fifty states are included in the Base Program Fees. All others please call.

SINGLE COURSE FEES: A Single Course Fee pays for all books, lesson plans, tests, grading, counseling, tuition, and shipping for a single course. As with the full curriculum enrollments, the lesson plans must be returned to us within 12 months of the original shipment date. Single courses are available for all subjects and grade levels. Prices vary by grade so please contact an Admissions Counselor for further information. There is a supplemental math book fee for Saxon 54 and above. All math books are \$20 and are yours to keep.

OTHER FEES NOT LISTED IN THE ENROLLMENT CONTRACT:

SINGLE COURSE EXCHANGE FEES: If you would like to exchange a course, you may do so *within 45 days* if the materials *have not been used*. Return the unused course materials and include a check for \$8.00 (\$15.00 US in CANADA) to cover shipping and handling. This exchange policy applies to any single course in Grades 1-12.

Although you are not able to *exchange* a kindergarten course for a higher course level, you may choose to enroll

your kindergarten child in one or more elementary level single courses at our regular single course prices.

If you have had *elementary* school materials for *more than 45 days* and would like a course exchange or upgrade, please contact our shipping dept., prices vary according to course. No exchanges are available after 6 months. (Math books purchased separately).

If you wish to exchange a *high school* course *after 45 days or after using the materials*, you will need to enroll in a single course at our regular single course prices.

COURSE EXTENSION FEES: You may need to extend your enrollment for more than the allotted 12 months. For an extension fee of \$75.00 for a full curriculum or \$25.00 for a single course, you may extend your enrollment for an additional 6 months. After that, the student must re-enroll.

This contract is valid for families residing in the U.S. and Canada and for families with an APO address. All others must request an international enrollment contract.

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

May we receive a discount if we do our own grading?

No. We feel very strongly that the assistance we provide your family with our counseling, our grading, and our record keeping are so valuable that we would be doing our families a disservice not to make those services part of our package price.

Are there discounts if I enroll several children in the Program?

Seton has a multi-child discount built into the tuition contract. This discount applies only to children enrolled simultaneously.

Does Seton have a payment plan?

Yes. Our Enrollment Contract explains the down payment and payment schedule for our standard payment plan. Please see FACTS description and application on the last page of the contract. Please understand that if you fall behind in your payments our services such as grading and access to MySeton will be discontinued until your account becomes current. Please contact us immediately if you are unable to make a payment.

If we have some of the books, will we receive a credit?

Yes, as long as you have made arrangements with us prior to the shipment of your order. **We are not able to give you a discount once the materials have been shipped.** Please realize the discount may not be what you pay for the book if you purchase it separately. Book credit forms are attached.

Does Seton offer a discount if all fees are paid in advance?

Yes. The prices given on our Enrollment Contract for full payment option include a pre-payment discount.

Who pays for postage for individual tests?

The parents pay for tests mailed to Seton. Seton pays for the tests returned to the parent, First Class Mail to students within the United States and Canada. Tests may be sent to Seton via the Internet.

Do you have a special services department?

Yes. We offer this service for children with special learning difficulties. An additional fee is required. More information is on the following page of this package.

REFUND POLICIES (EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2008)

1. Due to Seton's labor and material output in processing applications, the new family application fee is nonrefundable.
2. If cancellation should occur after the books have been shipped, an additional fee of \$25 per student will be retained by Seton, as well as any shipping and handling fees.
3. Once the books have been shipped, Seton will allow 20 business days from the shipment date for you to request a full refund, minus the nonrefundable fees. We will issue the refund provided the books have not been used and the books are returned within 5 business days of notification of cancellation. (All times are based on the shipment date, not the start date.)

Otherwise, the refund will be determined as follows:

4. If cancellation is requested,

after 1 month,	Seton is due 1/4 fees;
after 2 months,	Seton is due 1/2 fees;
after 3 months,	Seton is due 3/4 fees;
after 4 months,	Seton is due full fees.
5. If upon cancellation a refund is due from Seton, that refund will be mailed to the signer of the enrollment contract within 30 days of the date of receipt of the returned books.
6. No refund is available on kindergarten after two weeks.

Special Services Application

In order to continue to provide Special Services to students, we need to charge an additional fee per child to cover our expenses. A child with special learning needs is not required to use the services of our Special Services Department, but if you choose to do so the following will be provided:

Special Service Fee includes: If you choose to use this department throughout the year, in addition to the regular tuition, a service fee of \$125 for grades K-6 and \$175 for grades 7-12 will be charged. This fee covers phone counseling, initial evaluation of student records, curriculum customizing, continuing evaluation of student work throughout the year, grading and other services provided. **Additional materials, such as workbooks, are extra charges and are not included in this service charge.**

Completion of this application does not guarantee placement in the SSD. From time to time, a waiting list does exist. The number of students to be accepted in the SSD is limited by the number of qualified personnel at Seton who can service them. No credit cards will be charged or checks negotiated until placement in the department is verified.

Kindergarten and single courses must be paid in full at the time of application. Grades 1-12 may be paid either in full at time of enrollment or in installments. **If paying through FACTS, the entire down payment must be made before the curriculum can be shipped and the FACTS application has been returned to Seton or the online application is complete.** Additional fees will be charged to delinquent accounts. Enrollment in FACTS must be completed at the time of enrollment. Every legal effort will be made to collect unpaid account balances. **Final grades will not be released until all tuition and late fees have been paid.**

Multi-child discounts are built into our price schedule. However, any additional children enrolled at a later date will not be considered part of this Contract, and will not receive the multi-child discount.

Please read the application carefully. Please make sure you have completed all the appropriate boxes.

Any family which has never used the Seton Program or has not used it within the last 12 months must pay the **NEW FAMILY APPLICATION FEE**. This fee must be paid whether enrolling in a single course or a full program. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AUTHORIZATION: FACTS Management Co. (FACTS), Lincoln, Nebraska has contracted with the educational institution (Institution) identified in Section 1 of this FACTS Agreement (Agreement) to act as its agent for the collection of tuition and/or fees. **As the Responsible Party whose signature appears on this Agreement, you accept and agree to be bound by the Agreement's terms and conditions until the total amount owed is paid in full. Additionally, you authorize FACTS to initiate debit or charge entries to the account provided or any subsequent account.** Your authorization will continue for the next Institution year upon receipt of reenrollment information submitted to FACTS by the Institution identified in Section 1. (Such reenrollment will be governed by the terms and conditions of that year's applicable Agreement.) Your authorization will terminate when the total balance due has been paid (including fees, unless waived) and reenrollment information is not received for the next Institution year.

RETURNED PAYMENT FEE: In the event that your financial institution returns a payment, a \$25 FACTS Returned Payment Fee will be automatically processed from the account provided within 20 days. A returned payment fee will be assessed for each payment attempt that is returned. **If any returned payment fees are returned, they will be reattempted.** Fees are subject to change in future academic years.

PAYMENT DATES: If the payment date falls on a weekend or a banking holiday observed by the Federal Reserve, the payment will be attempted on the next business day. Although FACTS specifies the date each payment will occur, your financial institution determines the time of day the payment is debited to the account.

CUSTODIAL ACCOUNT: FACTS does not guarantee payments it does not collect from you. Collected funds shall be held by FACTS as your agent until remitted to the Institution. Depending upon the Institution's policy, payments returned by your financial institution will be automatically reattempted. Refunds of any money paid to FACTS, except for any applicable FACTS fees, will be handled by the Institution according to its refund policy. Interest earned on custodial funds is payable to FACTS.

CHANGES TO AGREEMENTS:

A. You may make changes to the information you provided in this Agreement by contacting the Institution identified in Section 1. In the event you authorize additional services from the Institution, or in the event additional fees are assessed by the Institution in accordance with Institution policy and as a result of changes authorized by you, you understand that the total balance due and/or payment amount will change. You agree that your authorization of any such change, including reenrollment for subsequent years, shall constitute your authorization to change the payment amount, and/or to continue payments until the total balance due is paid in full. You do not require FACTS or the Institution to send advance notice of any adjustments resulting from any such changed authorization, which includes any reduction in the balance due and/or payment as a result of financial aid, or any other similar cause, or resulting from any reenrollment. However, a copy of any such changed authorization or reenrollment is to be provided to you by the Institution.

B. If there will be any change in the preauthorized payment amount other than a changed authorization or reenrollment, as described above, the Institution will give you notice of such changed payment amount at least ten (10) days in advance of the next scheduled payment.

C. You may revoke your authorization/terminate your Agreement by sending FACTS a signed, written notification or an e-mail. Notification of termination must be received at least two (2) business days in advance of the next scheduled payment date. Please note that terminating your Agreement with FACTS in no way affects your obligation to pay the Institution. Your Institution may demand immediate payment of all outstanding balances. You are strongly encouraged to contact your Institution before requesting to terminate your Agreement.

CONFIRMATION: Any and all inconsistencies in the information provided will be resolved in the confirmation notification sent to you from FACTS. Changes made by the Institution that are received by FACTS before the notification is sent may also be included. In either event, the confirmation notification shall be controlling.

DISCOVERY OF SUSPECTED ERRORS: If you discover what you believe to be an error made by FACTS, you must report the suspected error to the company immediately. FACTS must hear from you no later than sixty (60) days after the suspected error occurred. This obligates you to timely review of your bank statements and a timely response to company letters, e-mails, or phone calls. It is your responsibility to report suspected errors as soon as possible.

GOVERNING LAW: You acknowledge that the origination of ACH transactions to your account must comply with the provisions of U.S. law. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Nebraska. The District Court of Lancaster County, Nebraska, shall be the sole venue for filing any action. This Agreement should in no way be construed to be a lender-borrower agreement between FACTS and the Institution or FACTS and you.

ARBITRATION: Upon the demand of you or FACTS, any dispute concerning the parties' duties or liabilities under this Agreement shall be resolved by binding arbitration in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. Arbitration proceedings shall be administered by the American Arbitration Association (AAA) or such other administrator as the parties shall mutually agree upon in accordance with the AAA Commercial Arbitration Rules. All disputes submitted to arbitration shall be resolved in accordance with the Federal Arbitration Act (Title 9 of the United States Code), notwithstanding any conflicting choice of law provision. The arbitration shall be conducted at a location in Lincoln, Nebraska selected by the AAA or other administrator. All statutes of limitation applicable to any dispute shall apply to any arbitration proceeding. All discovery activities shall be expressly limited to matters directly relevant to the dispute being arbitrated. Judgment upon any award rendered in arbitration may be entered in any court having jurisdiction.

PRIVACY AND SECURITY: Data collected and stored by FACTS pursuant to this Agreement is governed by the Institution's privacy policy. This data will not be used by FACTS in any manner not approved by the Institution unless required by law (for example, a court order or subpoena). Access to the data shall be restricted to authorized associates and shall be used only for the purpose of providing service to you or the Institution. FACTS maintains physical, procedural, and electronic safeguards to protect data from being accessed by unauthorized third parties. FACTS' privacy policy will govern use of your information only in the event that you request additional services directly from FACTS or its affiliates.

PEACE OF MIND (POM) CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE: If, as the person who has signed the front of this Agreement, you have checked the "Yes" box enrolling you in the Peace of Mind Benefit, this will serve as your Certificate of Insurance. The FACTS POM Benefit pays the remaining unpaid balance of the Agreement up to a Maximum Benefit Amount of \$30,000 and is subject to the conditions listed below:

1. The Maximum Amount applies to each Agreement and is initiated upon death of the *covered person*. *Covered person* means the person who has signed the Agreement or that person's legal spouse. The *covered person* must be under age 70 at the time coverage begins.
2. The amount of Benefit payable is limited to the outstanding balance owed to the student(s)' Institution, as budgeted through FACTS, up to the Maximum Benefit Amount. Payments in arrears, if any, are not covered. The Benefit is payable directly to the Institution specified on the Agreement.
3. The coverage effective date is the date on which the authorized signer has signed the Agreement. The nonrefundable POM fee must be received by FACTS in order to process a claim. Coverage ends on the due date of the last scheduled FACTS payment.
4. Coverage does not apply when cancer or complications related to cancer cause death, and the *covered person* has received or been advised to receive medical advice, diagnosis, or treatment for cancer at the time coverage begins.
5. Proof of death is required to obtain this Benefit. A certified copy of the death certificate must be given to the coverage provider or to FACTS.
6. This is an insurance agreement governed by the laws of the State of Missouri.
